### **Proposed Competition Rules' Changes**

#### **1. Rule 3a**

##### ***Current Rule***

A swimmer registered for a Club's B team at the commencement of the season can be re registered during the season if required to swim for the Club's A team. Swimmers are not allowed to register for the B team during that year's competition after being registered as an A team swimmer.

##### ***Proposed rule***

A swimmer registered for a Club's B or C team at the commencement of the season can be re registered during the season if required to swim for the Club's A or B team. Swimmers are not allowed to register for the B or C teams during that year's competition after being registered as an A team swimmer.

#### **2. Rule 4**

##### ***Current Rule***

Swimmers may only represent the Club for which they are first registered with the ASA in the year of competition, if applicable.

##### ***Proposed rule***

Delete in full and renumber 4a as 4.

### **3. Rule 10**

#### ***Current Rule***

The Home Team will be responsible for the organisation of the gala and should provide the following officials:

Referee (from the district list of officials)  
Starter (not required if the referee is prepared to do this)  
Announcer  
Recorder(s)

The Home Team will be responsible for the organisation of a Raffle including all Prizes

Each team attending the Gala will supply the following:

Team Manager  
Competition Stewards  
Timekeepers to be delegated lanes by the referee/starter  
Registered Official (for judging duties as required by the Referee)

#### ***Proposed Rule***

The Home Team will be responsible for the organisation of the gala and should provide the following officials:

Referee (from the district list of officials)  
Starter (not required if the referee is prepared to do this)  
Announcer  
Recorder(s)

The Home Team will be responsible for the organisation of a Raffle including all Prizes. The Home Team will charge £3.00 entry fee for spectators to include a raffle ticket. Any concessions will be at the discretion of the Home Team.

The Home Team can utilise a spare swim lane during a Gala. However, this must be non-competitive ie not form part of the Gala and must not cause any disruption to the competitive lanes.

Each team attending the Gala will supply the following:

Team Manager  
Competition Stewards  
Timekeepers to be delegated lanes by the referee/starter  
Competent Official/judge (for judging duties as required by the Referee)

### **4. Rule 14**

#### ***Current Rule***

The Hon Secretary or Micro League Representative of the home team should send the results, sheets, team sheets and any other relevant paperwork to the Hon Registration

Secretary within 5 working days. 10 points can be deducted from the home team's points total if paperwork is overdue, at the discretion of the executive committee.

***Proposed rule***

The Hon Secretary or Micro League Representative of the home team should send the signed results, sheets, team sheets and any other relevant paperwork to the Hon Registration Secretary and update the website within 5 working days. 10 points can be deducted from the home team's points total or be subject to a £10 fine if paperwork is overdue or the website not updated, at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

**5. New Rule 11k**

There will be a Top Performance Award given to the Boy and Girl within each Division scoring the most individual points.

**6. New Rule 14 C**

Failure to comply with Rule 10 will be subject to a fine of £10.

**7. New rule 16**

In the event of a team leaving the Micro League altogether, then numbers of teams and potential movement of teams within divisions will be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
